

SMART TUITION
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Payments are due the 1st of the month. Late fees will be applied after the 15th of the month.
Late fees accumulate with each subsequent delinquent payment.

If your tuition account isn't reflecting the in parish rate, please submit the Participating Parish Form to your parish. Additional forms are available at the Middle School office. Unless this form is signed and verified by your home parish, you will not receive the benefit of "in-parish" tuition and **will need to pay the out-of-parish rate.**

Parents, please review your tuition account prior to submitting your payment. To view charges to your account, go to the Review My Bill page and scroll down and click on My Billing Detail. This will display your current charges for the month. **Please submit the balance due on your account.**

The Athletic Fee of \$150 has been added to family accounts for those students participating in girls volleyball and boys basketball. **Please review your account prior to submitting your payment.**

The Before/After Program tuition has been added to family accounts for the students attending the morning/afternoon for the weeks of September 11th, September 18th, September 25th and October 2nd. This tuition amount is due on November 1, 2017. **Please review your account prior to submitting your payment. Note: Smart Tuition does not accept advance payments for the Before/After Program tuition.**
