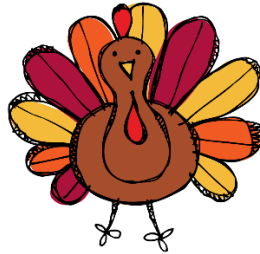

The following is a list of the most needed, non-perishable items that have been divided up by grade level. Donations will be collected in each classroom. These items will directly benefit the people of McHenry. Thank you for your support and your donations.

Preschool: canned meats or tuna (chicken, ham, hash, spam, tuna)
Kindergarten: canned meals or boxed meals (stew, pasta, chili, hamburger helper)
First grade: canned vegetables (green beans, peas, corn, potatoes, mushrooms)
Second grade: dry cereal & oatmeal
Third grade: dried pasta & rice
Fourth grade: peanut butter & jelly
Fifth grade: canned soups
Sixth grade: dried or canned beans (black, chili, kidney, pinto, white, refried, pork & beans)
Seventh grade: canned tomatoes & tomato sauces
Eighth grade: toilet paper/personal hygiene/household cleaning & paper products

A current and a former student of Montini are members of the Home Run Helpers (a group of baseball players helping our community), they will be serving free Thanksgiving Dinners, on November 23rd, at The Depot Restaurant in Richmond, for anyone that is in need of sharing a meal.

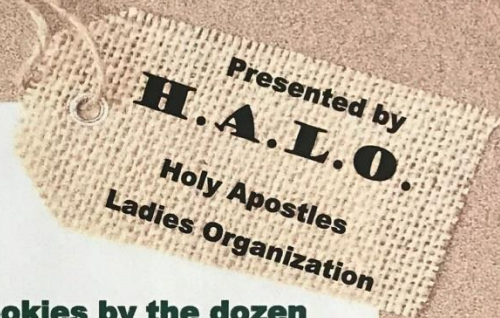

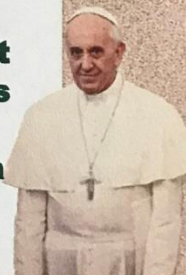

SMART TUITION

Payments are due the 1st of the month. Late fees will be applied after the 15th of the month. **Late fees accumulate with each subsequent delinquent payment.**

If your tuition account isn't reflecting the in parish rate, please submit the Participating Parish Form to your parish. Additional forms are available at the Middle School office. Unless this form is signed and verified by your home parish, you will not receive the benefit of "in-parish" tuition and **will need to pay the out-of-parish rate.**

Parents, please review your tuition account prior to submitting your payment. To view charges to your account, go to the Review My Bill page and scroll down and click on My Billing Detail. This will display your current charges for the month. **Please submit the balance due on your account.**

The Athletic Fee of \$150 has been added to family accounts for those students participating in girls volleyball and boys basketball. **Please review your account prior to submitting your payment.**

The 8th Grade Graduation Fee has been added to family accounts for those students in 8th grade. The fee of \$245 will be spread across 5 months beginning December 1, 2017 through April 1, 2018 at \$49/month. **Please review your account prior to submitting your payment.**

Every family in grades K-8 is required to pay the Family Fundraising Fee of \$160 per the 2017-2018 Montini Tuition Contract. This fee will give you 8 drawing tickets for the Grand Prize Drawing at Montini's Auction to be held in the spring of 2018. The \$160 fee will be applied to family accounts and spread across 4 months beginning January 1, 2018 through April 1, 2018 at \$40/month. **Please review your account in Smart Tuition prior to submitting your payment.** Once you receive your tickets from MPTA, please complete the information on the ticket and return to school prior to the auction.

(Note: you can sell your tickets to recoup your money)

The Before/After Program tuition for the students attending the morning/afternoon for the weeks of October 9th, October 16th, October 23rd and October 30th will be applied to your account the week of November 6th. This tuition amount is due on

December 1, 2017. **Please review your account prior to submitting your payment. Note: Smart Tuition does not accept advance payments for the Before/After Program tuition.**
